#### Wednesday 7 March



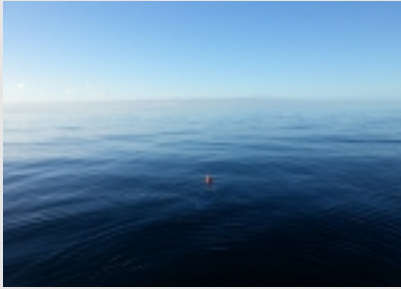
#### Estuaries and tipping points
